Annual Report for academic year 2013-14



A. Governance



- On 7th May 2013, Parama Puja Swamiji visited Srivali High School and blessed the teachers and students.
- The School Executive Committee continued to actively guide the students and teachers. Shri Alekal Ramachandra Rao, CEO of Saraswat Education Society, Mangalore and an experienced educationist with distinguished service in the Karnataka State Education department, joined Dr Krishnanand Hattangady and Shri Mahesh Bondal in charting the School's management.
- The SEC planned and executed the admissions process, communication with parents and teachers.
- 31st May 2013 marked the first day of the academic year with 101 students in class 10.

- Admissions to class 8 commenced on 10th June, and a total of 111 students were admitted from Anandashram Vidya Mandir, Shirali (80) and other feeder Schools (31). This made for a total of 350 students in the 3 classes, 8, 9 and 10.
- The School has Thirteen Teachers and two non-teaching staff, led by Head Mistress Smt Mamatha M Bhatkal.
- Three of the School's teachers, were nominated to attend a 3-day continuing education program conducted at Bhatkal which they completed successfully.

- Steps to further improve SSLC (class 10) results were discussed at a Head Masters' Meeting at Ankola, which Smt. Bhatkal attended. The Block Education Officer, Shri Devidas Moger also visited the School for inspection.
- The **Saath** Centre is conducted in partnership with Bangalore-based **Prema Vidya**. It is focused on making learning a more impressionable exercise by the use of audio-visual techniques. In the timetable drawn up for each division of class 8 and 10, two periods for each day are devoted to this learning technique. Students are assigned to 14 groups in each division, and are encouraged to write out their questions/doubts. This helps teachers to monitor individual students' grasp of each subject, and give them personal attention.
- They also guided the students' participation in speech, drama and cultural competitions as well as sports, across Taluka, District and State levels.
- Special efforts were made to address the needs of slow learners. Special classes for slow learners, and English language classes were also conducted by the Saath Centre alongwith Prema Vidya.
- 19 Solar lamps were distributed among deserving students to help them continue their studies in the evenings.

A. Recognition

- Shri Chitrapur Math was selected for Bhatkal Taluka-level award for its "Contribution in the field of Education". At the 2014 Republic Day function held at Parade Ground, Bhatkal, local MLA, Shri Mankal Vaidya presented the award (a Certificate) in the presence of the Assistant Collector, the Tahsildar and many other Officers. Shri Narayan Mallapur, General Manager, received the award.
- The Karnataka State Women and Children Welfare Department recognised Adarsh Krishna Revankar as an outstanding student of Uttar Kannada District for the academic year 2012-13, and awarded him a cash prize of Rs. 10,000/-.

B. Academics

- The first Parents-Teachers meeting for class 10th was held on 7th June 2013, followed by a similar meeting for class 8 at which the Headmistress addressed the audience on the rules and regulations of the School. The Sindhu House allocated school activities among the four Houses to which the students were assigned.
- In July, the first term test for class 10 students was conducted. In September, first Summative Examinations for 8th and 9th class; and Mid Term examinations for 10th class students were conducted. Students who had stood 1st and 2nd in each class were honoured at a function organized in November at the Janata Vidyalaya High School, Shirali.
- Progress cards were issued to students of class 8 and 9, on the CCE pattern. In August, the 2nd term test was held for class 10 (SSLC) students.
- In January 2014, 24 students attended a Motivational class conducted by the Bhatkal Education department.
- In the 2nd half of January, the School conducted Taluka-level preparatory examinations for S.S.L.C. students.
- In early February, District-level Preparatory Exams were held for S.S.L.C. students.
- One of the subjects where our students need special assistance is Mathematics. Hence, we are particularly thankful to Shri Goutam Heble who sent some mathematical games to improve their learning skills which will help the students to achieve better performance.
- **In results of class 10 announced on May 12, 2014, the School achieved 100% pass result, continuing its track record since inception.**

C. Academic,Cultural Competitions – participation & prizes

- On 29th June, Rakshit Hebbar of class 10 won the First Prize in the Taluka-level Speech Competition held by ‘Sneha Kunja Trust’, Honnavar at the New English School, Bhatkal.
- Adarsh Revankar and K L Nitin represented our School in winning the 1st prize at the Bhatkal Taluka-level IT Quiz competition held at English Medium School, Bhatkal.

- Adarsh Revankar and Nitin Naik bagged the 1st and 3rd prizes in the Drawing competition organized by the Bhatkal Education Department. Revankar also won the 2nd place in a District-level drawing competition held in Karwar.
- During Karavali Utsava, at a district-level Drawing, Essay and Folk Song competitions our students won two first prizes and a third prize respectively.

- In competitions organized by Janata Vidyalaya High School at Shirali, Rakshit Hebbar bagged the 1st prize in Speech and Bharat Naik, the 3rd prize in Bhagavad Gita recitation.
- Rakshit Hebbar participated in a Bhatkal Taluka-level seminar and was selected to represent the District. Bhavani Ulman won the 2nd Prize in a Taluka-level Essay Competition held in Bhatkal and was honoured at the 15th August ceremony at Bhatkal Police Ground.
- Rakshit Hebbar and Adarsh Revankar won the 1st prize of Rs 5,000 in the District-level Speech and Drawing competitions respectively, held at Manki ground, Kumta.
- The Pratibha Karanji cultural competition organized by the Education Department, is a prestigious state-level forum for children from across Karnataka state to display their talents.
 - ❖ In the cluster-level competition held at Vishwabharati High school, Bengre, our School was judged “All Rounder Champion”, winning twelve 1st places, six 2nd places and one 3rd place.
 - ❖ At the Taluka-level competition held at Shri Durgaparameshwari High School, Alvekodi, our students bagged seven 1st places, five 2nd places and two 3rd places.
 - ❖ In January, in the District-level competition at Satyagraha Smaraka Bhavan, Ankola, our students won the 1st prize in Drama, and the 1st prize in Drawing (thereby qualifying for State-level Pratibha Karanji competition). We also won the 2nd prize for Essay, 2nd for Hindi speech, and 3rd prize for Kannada speech, Debate and Konkani speech.
 - ❖ At the State-level competition held at Bijapur, Adarsh Revankar won 1st place in Drawing and Vinuta Moger was adjudged the Best Actress.
 - ❖ Rakshit Hebbar and Adarsh Revankar were honoured at Gibb High School, Kumta for their achievements in these competitions.
 - ❖ Rakshit Hebbar and Prashant Naik participated in ‘Yuva Samsat’ at Karwar. Rakshit secured 2nd place and qualified for the State level competition, in which he participated at Bangalore. Praveen Devadiga and Prajwal Naik won special mention in the debate competition organized by ‘Satyagraha Smaraka Vidyalaya’ at Ankola.
 - ❖ Our students secured three State-level Ranks in the Drawing Grade examination in which 30,000 students participated from all over Karnataka. Adarsh Revankar

won 1st prize in the Higher Grade exam, while Nitin T Naik won 3rd prize and Prashant M Naik won 8th prize in the Lower grade exam.

- ❖ Prashant Naik and Praveen Devadiga participated in the speech competition organized by the Education Department at Bhatkal. Prashant Naik secured First place.
- ❖ Our students, Prashant Naik and Mahendra Devadiga participated in 'Krusha Mela-2014' at Police ground, Bhatkal.

D. Sports

- At the Cluster-level sports meet in Shirali, our students won four 1st, four 2nd and six 3rd prizes in Running, Hurdles, Long Jump, High Jump, Triple jump, Shot Put, Discus throw, and two students qualified to compete at Taluka level. In group games (Kho-kho, Ball Badminton, Relay running and Volleyball), our boys and girls won four 1st and three 2nd prizes.
- At Taluka-level, our Boys won the first two prizes in hurdles, and Girls won the first and third prize in Shot put. We also won prizes in the Sprint, 800 mts, Boys relay and Kho-kho.

E. Key functions organized

- 4th of July 2013 was marked by a Vanamahotsava Programme, that witnessed active participation by all. Dr Krishnanand Hattangady had a day-long interactive session with the students and teachers. Science teachers conducted a program on 'Solid Waste Disposal' to introduce the topic to our students.
- In August, a visit to the Bhatkal Rural Police Station was organised to introduce the topics of General Safety and Laws.

- World Bio-Fuel Day was observed in co-operation with Sneha Kunja Trust, Honnavar; Shri Anant Hegde Ashishar, Chairman of Western Ghats Task Force addressed our students on eco-friendly energy sources.
- Independence Day was observed with traditional flag-hoisting and cultural programs put up by our students.
- Teachers' Day was observed on September 5th at which a retired teacher was invited to preside over the program.
- 1st November marked Kannada Rajyotsava day
- Children's Day on 14th November was commemorated by the Bhatkal Health Department organizing a speech competition among students, on 'Malarial disease'. This was followed by an informative talk on 'Importance of Bhagavad Gita' by Dr Hemant Kamath. A Gita recitation class was held daily for the next fortnight, led by Dr Kamath, Shri Ganesh Bankeshwar and Smt Arya Shukla.
- On 19th November, our school organized a Bhatkal Taluka-level Science Exhibition in our school premises. In this competition, our student Prashant Naik won the first prize in the 'Environmental Science' division.
- On 20th November, Kanaka Jayanti was observed.
- On 6th December, we conducted our school sports meet at our school ground.
- 13th December marked Gita Jayanti Day, and a 'Bhagavad-Gita' recitation competition was held at 'Shri Chitrapur Math'. Our School Annual Day program was organized that evening, with a Science exhibition, and numerous cultural programs such as songs, dance, skits and Yakshagana-s presented by our students.
- Besides Republic Day on 26th January, we observed Sarvodaya Day on the 30th January, marked by Essay and Singing competitions, and 'Shramadana' to clean the school premises in which our students participated actively.
- On 28th February, we celebrated 'The Science Day' at the school and our students performed various programmes on science and technology with the help of 'Science Club'.



F. Noteworthy visitors

- On 1st June, Trustee of Srivali Trust, Shri Dinesh Tonse gave a talk on School achievements and distributed Special Prizes to students who had appeared for the S.S.L.C. Examination.

- Smt. Sudha Rao, ex-Vice Chancellor of KSOU Mysore, visited the School and evinced keen interest in various activities.

- The Bhatkal Lok Adalat conducted an Awareness Programme on 'Law and Justice' in our school.

- Shri Devidas Moger, Bhatkal Block Education Officer visited our school on 18th February and observed the school activities.

- Shri S M Naik, retired Manager, Syndicate Bank addressed our students on the 'Banking Business'.
